WA STATE WAGE CASE DECISION 2019

Amended Wage Schedule – July 2019

Issue No. 4 of 2019

The Western Australian Industrial Relations Commission handed down the State Wage Case Decision on 14 June 2019, increasing all state award rates by 2.75%.

The new minimum rates will be effective as of the first full pay period commencing (1st PPC) on or after 1 July 2019.

Please note that the wage increase will apply only to employees who are paid the award wage, and that any wage paid above the award wage is able to be used to offset the increase made by the State Wage Decision. This means that you do not have to automatically apply an increase to your current rates of pay, but should only do so where they no longer meet the new minima.

Attached for your information is the updated Wage Schedule applicable to the *Clerks* (*Commercial, Social and Professional Services*) Award No. 14 of 1972.

Practices should also be aware that the *Clerks (Commercial, Social and Professional Services) Award* will only apply to those Practices that are not covered by Federal Modern Awards and the Fair Work Act, i.e. sole traders, partnerships of individuals or other unincorporated entities and non-trading corporations.
