Our advocacy activities in 2022 included:

- Finalising an Industrial Agreement with the WA Government on behalf of public hospital doctors, to provide sustainable improvements across the health system.
- Securing significant improvements to junior doctor employment contracts, including portability of leave arrangements.
- Securing a \$1 billion commitment from the Federal Government for primary care, which was confirmed in the Budget announced in October 2022.

- Working with the Federal Government to make telehealth permanent.
- Establishing a process to secure permanency of senior public hospital doctors.
- Lobbying the ACCC to block managed care by private health insurance providers.
- Preventing the implementation of adverse changes to HBF's medical gap arrangements and cuts in funding for a range of items.
- Directly supported over 960 members with individual issues through our Advocacy and Industrial Relations team.

In 2023, we are...

- Commencing negotiations to replace the SJOG – AMA (WA) – Medical Practitioners. Enterprise Agreement 2021 and the RFDS (WO) Medical Practitioners Enterprise Agreement 2019.
- Continuing to fight to secure an improved salary outcome in line with others in the public sector.
- Ensuring the views and knowledge of WA doctors is heard by the independent panel reviewing WA's COVID-19 management and response.
- Fighting for patients and representing healthcare workers at KEMH and WA's Women's and Newborns Health Service, to ensure WA Government accountability and transparency in relation to future service and infrastructure decision making.
- Working alongside the government to make telehealth permanent.
- Facilitating the introduction of permanent employment for senior public hospital doctors by the end of 2023.
